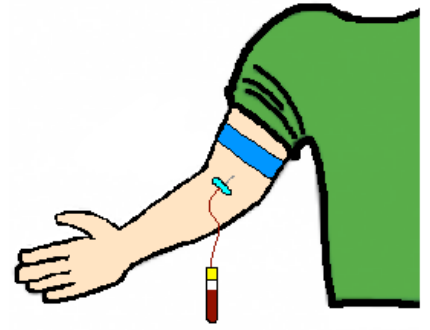


How to check your test results

Blood test or scan at the hospital or at the GP practice



The doctor looks at your results. They write a message about them on the computer.



You should check the doctor's message by looking on the NHS App or phoning the practice. You can phone between 2pm and 6pm.



You might be told to book an appointment to talk to the doctor about your results.

You might be told your results are normal. If your results are normal but you are still feeling unwell, you should make another appointment with the doctor.

The doctor might send you a text or call you about your results. You should still use the NHS App or phone Reception to check the rest of your results.
